



Sussex County Horse Show 2015 Scholarship Program



The Sussex County Horse Show Committee is pleased to announce that scholarships will be awarded to three (3) college students during the Sussex County Horse Show at the New Jersey State Fair on Saturday, August 8, 2015 on the night of the \$30,000 Grand Prix. The scholarships will consist of three (3) \$500 scholarships that have been sponsored by generous donations made by East Coast Equine Veterinary Services, LLC and the general fund of the Sussex County Horse Show.

Eligibility: To be eligible for scholarship consideration, the applicant must:

1. Be a resident of Sussex County, N.J. (local Western or local English scholarships only).
2. Be currently enrolled in a college or university for the Fall of 2015.
3. Have exhibited good citizen traits and be of sound moral character.
4. Have equine experience in the disciplines of English or Western riding and have actively participated in showing at the Sussex County Horse Show within the past three years.

Scholarship Awards: Scholarship awards will be awarded in amounts of \$500 to three (3) Applicants. One (1) scholarship will be awarded for an Applicant with a local English riding background, one (1) scholarship will be awarded to an Applicant with a local Western riding background, and one (1) scholarship will be open to a local or non-local Applicant with an equine background that has actively participated in showing at the Sussex County Horse Show.

Procedure: All Applicants will be required to 1) Complete the attached application form, 2) Provide an essay illustrating their past equine experience and the impacts that these experiences have had on their life, and 3) Provide a copy of most recent high school report card or college semester grades and proof of enrollment at a college or university for the Fall 2015 semester.

Recipient Selection: All Applicants will be considered on the basis of individual merit, good moral character, and their potential to succeed in the field of higher education. Selection process of choosing the scholarship recipients may include an interview of candidates.

Deadline For Submission: July 31, 2015
